Team & "Normal" Season Plan

- Our teams train in the area codes of 94949 and 94903. All our home games are played in this area.
- Approximately 45% of away games are played between San Jose, Sacramento and Santa Rosa. Approximately 5% of away games are played outside of that area. Some teams may participate in out-of-state tournaments.
- The season is year-round starting early June and ending May 31 with few breaks thorough the year.
- At the beginning of each season (or once league and tournament play is allowed), each team will meet, after the team manager and treasurer have been appointed. Parents will be presented with a team outline and budget for the year. The budget will include cost and dates for things like coach reimbursement, tournaments entry fees, league fees, referees, and any additional optional team equipment.



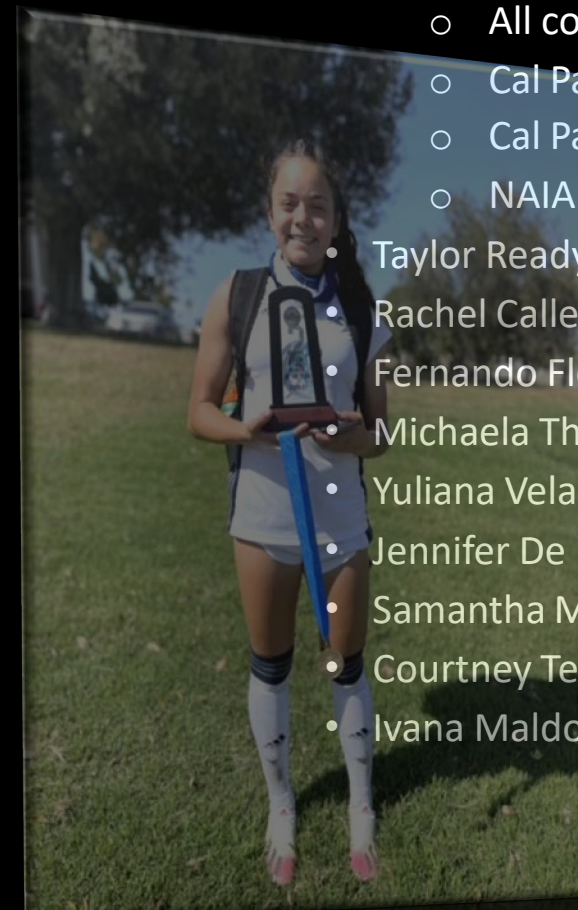
League and Tournament Play

U8 – 2014 and 2015	Starts with 4 v 4 or 5 v 5 and progresses towards learning 7 v 7. Play in local league and does a few small sided local tournaments throughout the year. Optional winter leagues and futsal will be offered.
U9 – U10 2013 and 2012	7 v 7 Plays in local region 5 Norcal Fall and Spring league. Participates in local tournaments. Returning teams will have the option to play in a summer league. Optional winter leagues and futsal will be offered.
U11 – U12 2011 - 2010	9 v 9 Plays in Norcal Fall and Spring League. Participates in local tournaments. Returning teams will have the option to play in a summer league. Optional winter leagues and futsal will be offered. High level 2010 players may have playing opportunities with elite level programs such as MLS Next, ODP and PDP
U13 – U19 2009 and older.	<p>11 v 11. Plays in either and/or both Norcal and Cal North for fall and spring league. Participates in local, regional and possible national tournaments. Fees

Club Registration Fee -

These fees pay for club operations; fields, insurance, administration, affiliation fees, equipment, etc.

A 10% discount on the 2nd sibling and 15% discount on the 3rd sibling. The discount will be taken on the 3rd registration payment.

Team Fees –

- Paid directly to team account. The club does not take this money.
- Includes but not limited to; league play, tournaments, referee, travel, coaching, and other team costs. These costs are discussed with the entire team at the first team meeting of the season.
- Every team is unique depending on level of play. Each team may have a different set of team fees.
- HS age players do not incur any team fees during the months of December, January and February.

- Black Game Socks


